The core objective of EMOPS is to foster better cooperation and good practice exchange between Erasmus coordinators in Political Science in order to improve the quality and quantity of mobility and thereby improve the quality and relevance of higher education

The project addresses the need for transparent information about Erasmus exchange opportunities and benefits in an openly accessible form. The core objectives of the project are to implement a database and an accompanying staff training programme for Erasmus coordinators. The database is a transparency tool that enables structured, comparable, and accessible information about various aspects of Erasmus mobility, including curricula, grade recognition, internships, academic department profiles, attempts toward interdisciplinarity, and internationalisation strategies of participating organisations. The staff training programme provides Erasmus coordinators with competences and skills necessary for an efficient use of the database in order to realise excellent performance in mobility administration.

The main activities of the project are (1) to implement, test, and promote the database, (2) to launch, test, promote, and implement an accompanying staff training programme for Erasmus coordinators, (3) to disseminate the intellectual output of the database among the "European Network of Erasmus Coordinators in Political Science, International Relations, Public Administration and Management", and (4) to reach out to Erasmus coordinators outside the network in related disciplines of Social Sciences and the Higher Education area (with a focus on the West Balkan region).
